VARIATIONS TO UNDERGRADUATE RULES OF ASSESSMENT FOR NON-ACCELERATED DELIVERY MODE

Academic Year 2019-20

(cohort first registered in this Year)

In respect of all non-accelerated degree courses;

EG1.0 In addition to the standard rules for progression, students on all Edge Hotel School courses must pass the Edge Hotel School Professional Code of Conduct.

Foundation Degrees

- **EG2.0** If a student does not meet the requirements for a Foundation degree:
 - **EG2.1** If 240 credits have been attempted and 225 have been passed but the student has not satisfied the professional code of conduct the student may be considered for the award of Diploma of Higher Education.

BA Hons courses including year abroad variants

- **EG3.0** If a student does not meet the requirements to progress:
 - **EG3.1** if 120 credits at level 4 or above have been passed, the student will be considered for the award of a Certificate of Higher Education.
 - **EG3.2** If 240 credits have been attempted and 225 have been passed but the student has not met the professional code of conduct the student may be considered for the award of Diploma of Higher Education.
- **EG4.0** If a student does not meet the requirements for an Honours degree:
 - **EG4.1** If 240 credits (including a minimum of 120 at level 5 or above) have been attempted and 225 have been passed, the student will be considered for the award of a Foundation Degree.

This can be awarded at the level of Pass, Merit or Distinction in accordance with the EHS Foundation Degree Rules of Assessment.
