#### **Terms and conditions**

#### **Eligibility**

- This bursary is restricted to students who have completed their studies at one of our Schools and Colleges Membership Plus, London, South East or Midlands schools/colleges in academic year 2025-26 (noted in the tables above).
- Students must be progressing directly from their studies at one of the named schools/colleges listed above.
- Students must register for their first year of a full-time undergraduate degree\*\* at the University of Essex in October 2025-26.
- UCAS applicants must actively make Essex their firm choice by 12 September 2025. Applicants that become firm with Essex through rejection by their original firm choice selection elsewhere are not eligible. Direct applicants via Clearing must actively accept their offer and make Essex their firm choice by 12 September 2025.
- This bursary may be held in conjunction with other University of Essex awards, including but not limited to:
  - Essex Futures Bursary 2025-26;
  - Essex Preparation Programme Bursary 2025-26.
- This scholarship/bursary is available for the first year of study at undergraduate level in 2025-26 only.
- Successful recipients should be available for promotional activities.
- \*\*Courses leading to the award of a Diploma of Higher Education, Foundation Degree, Bachelors Degree, Integrated Masters (four years)

## Students who are not eligible

The following students are NOT eligible for this scholarship regardless of meeting the above criteria:

- Students undertaking a degree that is normally delivered wholly online.
- Students awarded the scholarship who defer entry to following academic years will be ineligible to receive the award and will be considered in line with the terms and conditions that apply in the new proposed year of entry.
- Students transferring into the second year from another UK higher education institution.

- Students directly continuing from one course to another (for example from Foundation degree or HND on to the final year of an honours degree).
- Students who are fully or partly sponsored by their government or other external agency and are not required to make any repayments (this does not include VISA sponsorship)

#### How to apply

If applicants meet all the eligibility criteria, they will automatically be identified via the school or college listed on the undergraduate application form (UCAS or direct). Successful students will be contacted via email by the end of September 2025.

#### **Payment arrangements**

- The bursary is worth £1,000 for the first year of study in 2025-26 only. Payment will be made in two instalments, usually in February and May by bank transfer. Students are required to open a UK bank account to receive payment. We will contact all successful students by email before the payment date to request that bank details are entered into My Essex to ensure that payment can be made.
- Students must be registered and meet the above conditions to receive payment.
- Please note that if our records show that debt is owed to the University when an award payment is due, the payment will be offset against the student account in the first instance, and any balance remaining will be paid.

## **Bursary suspension**

The bursary will be suspended during a period of approved leave of absence (intermission) where this period covers a whole or part of an academic year and may be reinstated on return to full-time study subject to the conditions above. On return to study, students will be entitled to the balance of the bursary for the stage. There will be no payment for repeat periods of study in any circumstances.

# **Resolution of disputes**

Acceptance of this award constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions. Registered students should contact the <u>Funding Team</u> in the first instance for guidance regarding this award. In cases not covered by the above terms and conditions, or where a student claims exceptional circumstances, or disputes a decision not to make payments due under an award, final appeals on decisions regarding eligibility must be made via the <u>Student Complaints process</u>. The Academic Registrar or their nominee will review the case and his/her decision will be final.

These terms and conditions apply to the academic year 2025-26. The University of Essex reserves the right to update these terms and conditions as necessary.
