Terms and conditions

Eligibility

- The award is restricted to students who are entirely self-funded*
- Students must register for the first year of FdA Therapeutic Communication and Therapeutic Organisations, both the on-campus and online variant of the programme at the University of Essex in October 2025-26.
- This discount is applied to each year of study on this programme.
- Students must also be a member of staff (full-time or part-time) at a school/college listed in the tables above, as evidenced by an official letter from your employer.
- This award cannot be held in conjunction with any other University of Essex scholarships or discounts, however, may be held in conjunction with other University of Essex bursaries.
- Successful applicants should be available for promotional activities.

Students who are not eligible

The following students are NOT eligible for this award regardless of meeting the above criteria:

- The BA top up year following FdA completion is not included in this discount.
- Students awarded the scholarship who defer entry to following academic years will be ineligible to receive the award and will be considered in line with the terms and conditions that apply in the new proposed year of entry.

How to apply

Students should have stated on their course application that they are currently employed by a Schools and Colleges Membership institution (listed in the tables above) and provided an official letter confirming this. Students will automatically receive this discount, and do not need to complete a separate application process.

If this was not included in the course application process, please email <u>ugquery@essex.ac.uk</u> with an official letter from the employer.

^{*}Students receiving a repayable loan to fund their studies will be considered as self-funded.

Once this evidence has been checked and the award is approved, the fee discount will be applied at the point of confirmation by the Undergraduate Admissions Office and will be applied as a reduction of 25% on the annual tuition fee for each year of study for the programme.

Payment arrangements

- This discount will only be made available as a reduction on the tuition fee that is payable on registration at the University. Payment cannot be offset against a tuition fee deposit if one is required.
- Students who intermit from their course, may at the discretion of the University, be entitled to a prorata payment of the remainder of the award on return to study. Please contact the <u>Funding Team</u> for further information.

Resolution of disputes

Acceptance of this award constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions. Registered students should contact the <u>Funding Team</u> in the first instance for guidance regarding this award. In cases not covered by the above terms and conditions, or where a student claims exceptional circumstances, or disputes a decision not to make payments due under an award, final appeals on decisions regarding eligibility must be made via the <u>Student Complaints process</u>. The Academic Registrar or their nominee will review the case and his/her decision will be final.
